Dear Tarentum Borough Manager and Members:



Dear Honorable Mayor, Council Members, & Mr. Nestico:

My name is Sandra M. Collins, and I wish to be considered for appointment to the Second Ward Council Seat opened by the election of Mr. Carter as Tarentum Mayor last November.

Most of you are acquainted with me as I have been a lifelong resident of the area, have lived in Tarentum for over 50 years, and regularly attend Tarentum Council meetings. This coming September, my family will have lived in the same house at 209 Main Street for 53 years. I moved back to the homestead in 2002, two years after my dad, Mr. George T. Collins, died. Some of you are very familiar with him, as well; he worked for Tarentum Borough for close to 30 years before retiring in 1992.

To tell you a bit about myself, I am a member of Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament Parish, Natrona Heights, and am involved in the Music Ministry as a cantor. I consider myself retired although I keep busy maintaining the property and caring for my mother, Mrs. Helen Collins, whom some of you also know, and I have a younger brother, Mark.

I am interested in the position because I care deeply about my hometown and remember all Tarentum had to offer when I was growing up and as a young adult. Although obvious improvements, mostly aesthetic, have been made to Tarentum in recent years, I am concerned about other elements of the Borough's current condition and would like to have a voice in addressing those issues, and an opportunity to find solutions to situations that negatively affect our town and surrounding communities.

These challenges are not unique to Tarentum, certainly, but have become more pervasive, and invasive, and have many residents disappointed and discouraged. There have been recent, significant changes to Tarentum's government with the last election. Michael Nestico:

I am interested in remaining on the Tarentum Recreation Board. I am very interested in keeping the people of Tarentum informed, especially with historical things and other events in town.

I am mostly interested in the history of Tarentum and love to tell the people what I know and take them on tours so they can see for themselves the history of their town TARENTUM.

I was on the board for only one year and that was to fill a vacancy. Before that I was always doing historical tours and talks for different organizations such as the library, Masonic Lodge, Cub Scouts and the Rotary and others. I also help with the schools, teaching the history. I do power points of Tarentum one day at school, about 7 periods, and then the next day bring the students on a bus to Tarentum to see what they had learned the day before. I have done this for the High School and the Middle School. I worked with Grandview (grade school) for 2 summers doing a compass camp. I would make booklets for the students, walk them around town, some of the buildings we would go inside and the owner would talk about their business and usually give the students a little trinket. Then we would end up at the train station, upstairs, and have something to drink and discuss the tour, then walk back to the school. It was a great time.

Last year was a great year with all the historical activities that we (Recreation Board) had for the community. Ken Gulik was on at least one of my tours and called me and said how much he enjoyed the tour and wanted to know if there were any buildings for sale in town. He has now purchased the PRAHA. This is a great thing that happened.

I am the President of the Prospect Cemetery, Brackenridge, Pa. (on the board since 2009, President since May 2014), Vice President of the Library Board, (on the board since 2007, Vice President since 2017), member of the Tarentum Recreation Board, Executive Director of Tarentum History and Landmarks Foundation for 5 years, member for 35 years, (group folded after 40 years) and the Tarentum Historian.

All the booklets we, THLF made over the 40 years are in the Tarentum Library. They are all history of the valley.

I got the obituary books put in the Tarentum Library that THLF made. (Obits from 1904 - 2012 Valley News.) THLF also purchased microfilm of the Valley News, New Ken Dispatch, and the Freeport Journal and put them in the library. THLF also got Sanborn maps of the local area and had them bound and put in the library when I was the Director.

I was Exec. Director of THLF when we had the blue sign from Pennsylvania State Commission put in the Marina, we also had all the Landmark Plaques put on historic buildings in Tarentum. Nine of them were purchased when I was director of THLF.

Tarentum History and Landmarks Foundation and the Tarentum Book Club had the new HEBE put at the entrance to the Tarentum Bridge. The original HEBE was destroyed by a hit and run driver. HEBE had been in Tarentum since June 6, 1912.

I manage the Face Book page, Tarentum History with Cindy and co-manage the Face Book page for the Recreation Board with Hugh Fox. I love doing this and being the Historian of the town I love.




