

ORDINANCE NO. 13-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE 86-5 AND CHAPTER 250 OF THE TARENTUM CODE WHICH PRESCRIBES TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS, LIMITS TRUCK WEIGHTS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS, PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND WHICH CODIFIES CERTAIN EXISTING TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS, WHICH AMENDMENT ADDS A STOP SIGN GOING SOUTH AT THE INTERSECTION OF EAST 6TH AVENUE AND LOCK STREET.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Borough of Tarentum has declared an emergency requiring a stop sign being placed going South at the intersection of East 6th Avenue and Lock Street; and

WHEREAS, there are currently stop signs East and West at the same intersection; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Tarentum desires to amend Ordinance 86-5 Chapter 250 of the Tarentum Code for the purposes of public safety and to alleviate emergency conditions; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of East 6th Avenue and Lock Street has been identified as unsafe;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of Tarentum Borough and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 22 of CHAPTER 250 of the Tarentum Borough Code is hereby amended to add a stop sign at the intersection of East 6th Avenue and Lock Street going South. The intersection of East 6th Avenue and Lock Street shall have stop signs for traffic going East, South, and West.




