

ORDINANCE NO. 07-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE 86-5 AND CHAPTER 250 OF THE TARENTUM CODE WHICH PRESCRIBES TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS, LIMITS TRUCK WIGHTS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS, PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND WHICH CODIFIES CERTAIN EXISTING TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS, WHICH AMENDMENT ADDS STOP SIGNS EAST AND WEST AT THE INTERSECTION OF EAST 10TH AVENUE AND MILL STREET.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Borough of Tarentum has declared and emergency requiring stop signs being placed East and West at the intersection of East 10th Avenue and Mill Street; and

WHEREAS, there are currently stop signs North and South at the same intersection; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Tarentum desires to amend Ordinance 86-5 and Chapter 250 of the Tarentum Code for the purposes of public safety and to alleviate emergency conditions; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of East 10th Avenue and Mill Street has been identified as unsafe;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of Tarentum Borough, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.


SECTION 22 of Chapter 250 of the Tarentum Borough Code is hereby amended to add two stop signs at the intersection of East 10th Avenue and Mill Street. The intersection of East 10th Avenue and Mill Street shall have stop signs for traffic going North, East, South and West.
