**WHEREAS**, our local governments are a testimony to liberty, freedom, and the right to elected self-government; and




**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough of Tarentum recognizes April 14-18, 2014, as "Local Government Week" in Pennsylvania.

The undersigned certifies that the above Resolution was adopted at their regular council meeting by the Tarentum Borough Council on March 17, 2014.


