RESOLUTION 10 – 13**

**A RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ASSESSING A FIVE DOLLAR A MONTH SURCHARGE ON EACH WATER ACCOUNT TO FUND A FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY MANDATED COMBINED SEWER MONITORING.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2009, the Upper Allegheny Joint Sanitary Authority, Harrison Township, Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township, East Deer Township, the Borough of Brackenridge, and the Borough of Tarentum entered into a Consent Order with the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Order mandates the above respondents to take affirmative action to comply with the Order; and

**WHEREAS**, the action includes manhole inspection, televising combined sanitary and rain water sewer lines, flow monitoring and repair and/or remediation thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the above fixed costs are predicted to be at least Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000.00) dollars to the Borough of Tarentum; and

**WHEREAS**, Council of the Borough of Tarentum has determined the fairest way to pay for the costs without a permanent rate increase is to surcharge each water account the sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars per month;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Borough of Tarentum and it is hereby Resolved by authority of same:


1. Effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011, each water account shall be assessed five (\$5.00) dollars per month to fund the Environmental Protection Agency mandated costs; and


2. A separate distinguished account shall be established by the Borough of Tarentum into which Five (\$5.00) dollars from each water account monthly payment shall be deposited upon receipt; and
3. All costs and only those costs required by the Consent Order shall be paid out of said separate account.
