**A. Current Projects:**

**1. Tarentum Consent Order and Agreement (Sanitary Sewers)**

**Borough Responsibilities**

- A. Once lines are cleaned, RedZone plans to go back out to finish unfinished items.
- B. GTE working to determine what is left to be CCTV'd and what needs to be cleaned prior to CCTV. A new line was found and GTE is currently trying to decipher the mapping.
- C. Tarentum Borough received a \$100,000 grant through the Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund (GEDTF) for the 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Ormond Street storm sewer installation and \$290,683 through the CDBG program. This project is required to be completed under the consent order and agreement. **This project is ready to be bid, however, the GEDTF grant agreement was never processed by the county. Waiting for their notification to proceed.**

**2. Received ARLE Grant for traffic signal replacement at the intersection of East 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Corbett Street.**

- Notice to proceed given to the contractor (waiting for material delivery).
- Status of right-of-way for project (Tarentum handling).

**3. CDBG year 47- Sanitary Sewer Line Lining**

- AVNCOG issued the notice to proceed. Waiting for Schedule from Contractor (Jet Jack). Followed up with Contractor and provided AVNCOG with an update regarding project.

**4. CDBG Applications for year 48- Sanitary Sewer System Repairs**

- Project was funded by CDBG/AVNCOG. Estimated project costs \$152,054. Grant amount \$98,835. Tentative bid schedule- Fall 2022. AVNCOG reached out regarding CDBG looking to set up funding contract for this project. GTE provided AVNCOG with all requested documentation for funding contract to be set up.

**5. CDBG Applications for year 49**

- a. West 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue – New Waterline
- b. Collins Way – Spring Run Off
- Final applications were submitted for September 16<sup>th</sup> to AVNCOG.

## 6. CFA Applications

- Three applications were submitted for the March 15, 2022 deadline. Still waiting on grant selection by the CFA.

## 7. CFA Funding Opportunities

- Two new funding programs have opened with the Department of Community and Economic Developments:
  - **Covid-19 ARPA PA Small Water and Sewer Program**
    - \$105.6 Million available for projects between \$30,000 and \$500,000
    - Requires 15% Matching Funds
    - The deadline for applications is December 21<sup>st</sup>
  - **Covid 19 ARPA H2O PA Water Supply, Sanitary Sewer and Storm Water Projects.**
    - \$205.4 Million available for projects between \$500,000 and \$2,000,000
    - Requires 50% Matching Funds
    - The deadline for applications is December 21<sup>st</sup>
