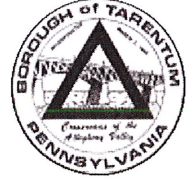

ORDINANCE #19-04

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 05-02, ENTITLED AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ENTER INTO A JOINT MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH FRAZER TOWNSHIP FOR THE PROVISION OF POLICE PROTECTION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WITHIN FRAZER TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 3301.1, entitled "Ordinances and Resolutions", Borough Council is authorized to make and adopt Ordinances necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Borough, and the maintenance of the health and welfare of the Borough and its citizens, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of Tarentum Borough ordained and enacted Ordinance No. 05-02, on January 17, 2005, entitled Authorizing the Borough to enter into a joint municipal agreement with Frazer Township for the provision of police protection and law enforcement services within Frazer Township, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 3301.1, entitled "Ordinances and Resolutions", Borough Council may repeal Ordinances in which general or specific powers of the Borough may be exercised by the enactment of subsequent Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Council of the Borough of Tarentum, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of same that Ordinance No. 05-02 entitled Authorizing the Borough to enter into a joint municipal agreement with Frazer Township for the provision of police protection and law enforcement services within Frazer Township is hereby repealed.
