REGULAR MEETING

SEPTEMBER 27, 2018

The regular meeting was called to order by President Carrie Fox at 6:00 p.m.

Roll call: Members present: Carrie, Becky May, Hugh Fox, Loraine White, Gina Landa and Barbara Magnosta. Tim Rapp came in later.

Becky made the motion to accept the minutes of August 28. Seconded by Gina, approved by all.

Gina came up with some wonderful new ideas for events we could have in the spring. A first ever, a Trash to Treasure at the parking lot by the Train Station Restaurant, since they are closed on Sundays. Possibly 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. How about a "Breakfast Bash for Kids" up to age 7, Possibly to be held at Holy Martyrs Hall. Tim wants to be Captain Crunch. The more fun, the better. Her next idea was a "Love me Tenders" Elvis Bingo. To be held February 14, 2019.
