## RESOLUTION #20-02

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AUTOMATED RED LIGHT ENFORCEMENT FUNDING PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Tarentum, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, previously submitted a 2019 Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) Funding Program Application in the amount of \$226,000 to be used for traffic signal replacement and public improvements of the intersection located at East 10th Avenue and Corbet Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Tarentum, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, has been awarded funding in the amount of \$226,000 and desires to execute the project funding agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Tarentum does hereby designate the Borough Manager (the "Authorized Official") as the official to execute the Grant Agreement, all future grant-related documents and forms between the Borough of Tarentum and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
