

The motion carried unanimously.



Utilities	 Water - 2020.08 - Water Plant Report ❖ Motion by Mr. Bonner, second by Ms. Fox to adopt Resolution #20-10: RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA DESIGNATING THE RATES FOR METERED WATER SOLD BY THE BOROUGH TO ITS CUSTOMERS, INCLUDING THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST DEER AND REPEALING ALL RATES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH. Discussion on the motion: Mr. Bonner presented the details surrounding the rate modifications found in the Resolution. Rate details include the following: Reduction in rates to 5/8" customers from \$25.00 to \$23.00 per month. Rates were raised to \$25.00 in 2017. Increase rates on other size pipes (not raised in 2017). Almost 10 years since last increase. 15% increase across the board. Increase the overage rate for all customers. \$0.90 per 1000 gallons for all overage. The new rates present a more equitable distribution for all users of water. For those that reduce consumption it will help to save money on their bills. The motion carried unanimously. ❖ Motion by Ms. Fox, second by Mr. Bonner to approve the upgrade of the Tarentum Borough smart meter Regional Network Interface (RNII) to a cloud-based Software as a Service (SaaS) solution and further upgrade the existing Meter Data Management (MDM) system to cloud-based Sensus Analytics (SA) software at a project upgrade cost not to exceed \$45,956.
