A. Current Projects:

1. Tarentum Consent Order and Agreement (Sanitary Sewers)

Borough Responsibilities

- A. RedZone Robotics mobilized in July 2021 to camera lines to locate buried manholes. Public Works Department is following behind and uncovering manholes.
- B. Manager will review budget/financing for the remaining jet cleaning/televising that is required by the consent order.
- C. Tarentum Borough received a \$100,000 grant through the Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund (GEDTF) for the 7th Avenue and Ormond Street storm sewer installation and \$290,683 through the CDBG program. This project is required to be completed under the consent order and agreement and is estimated at \$555,000. UAJSA previously agreed to bid/inspect the project, however, the grant agencies will not transfer the grants to UAJSA, therefore Tarentum will need to proceed with the project.

2. Cost Reimbursement (PennDOT)

 Supplied PennDOT with additional documentation as requested, awaiting reimbursement from PennDOT.

3. Received ARLE Grant for traffic signal replacement at the intersection of East 10th Avenue and Corbett Street.

 The final design has been completed and submitted to PennDOT for final approval. Bidding is anticipated in the Fall.

4. CDBG year 47- Sanitary Sewer Line Lining

The Bid opening will be held at Senate Eng. Co. Offices on Friday, October 29,2021

5. CDBG Applications for year 48

- CDBG applications for year 48 was submitted for the September 17, 2021 deadline.
 - (a) Project consists of a pipe repair on Davidson Street and 9th Avenue. In addition, we will be repairing/replacing 20 manholes throughout the system.

6. 2021 Paving Project

• Work is completed.

7. Center Street Traffic Study

• All analysis is completed. Final report will be submitted to the Borough in September.
