Mr. Boddorf noted that we need a communications platform to get information out to multiple communities. We were awarded \$20,000.00 to institute Savvy Citizen across all three communities. We can section off notifications by towns or all three communities. We will work over the next four to eight weeks to get the platform up and running. The more people we can get to sign up for this, the better. The platform is very cost-effective. The company headquarters are in the Pittsburgh region as well. Mr. Dadowski stated he knows they help with the marketing materials. Mr. Boddorf noted we currently pay about \$5,000.00 for our current platform, which doesn't communicate across municipal boundaries.  Discussion on 215 Corbett Redevelopment  Mr. Boddorf wanted to discuss the Council's vision for redeveloping 215 Corbet. He asked about the possibility of putting up a raised deck or gazebo, specifically for events, choirs, night markets, etc. Mr. Kerr noted there are five parking spaces now, but if we put in angled spaces, we could get almost eight.  Discussion on Act 172 of 2016 for Fire Departments  Mr. Boddorf discussed Act 172 and what that could do for the volunteer

firefighters, and there is time to discuss it. Mr. Nolan added that we must also ensure we are covering EMS and Hazmat. Mrs. Fox noted that we are very blessed
