ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TARENTUM, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDIANCE 86-5 TO INCLUDE THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF LOCK AND 4TH STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Tarentum seeks to ensure the safety and well-being of all residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, traffic conditions at the intersection of Lock and 4th Street have necessitated additional measures to regulate traffic and enhance safety; and

WHEREAS, the installation of stop signs at this intersection is necessary to control vehicle flow and prevent accidents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Council of the Borough of Tarentum, that Ordiancne 86-5 be amended as follows:

Section 1. INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS The Department of Public Works is hereby directed to install stop signs facing south at the intersection of Lock and 4th Street, thereby requiring all vehicles traveling southbound on Lock Street to come to a complete stop at the 4th Street intersection.

Section 2. DESIGN AND PLACEMENT The stop signs shall be installed in accordance with the standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and PennDOT.

Section 3. ENFORCEMENT This ordinance shall be enforced by the Tarentum Borough Police Department. Violations of this stop sign requirement shall be handled according to the municipal code of Tarentum Borough.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
