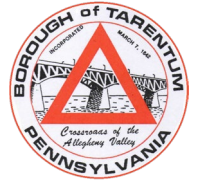

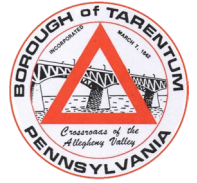

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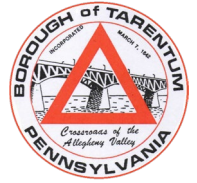
Borough Manager Boddorf noted that we could do many things, but it would be up to the Council.

- Discussion on 4th of the July Fireworks donation authorization

- Discussion on Mural
The Recreation Board approved the expenditure of funds at their last meeting, and the design remained the same.
- Discussion on tree trimming
Several business owners asked about tree trimming, and we received several quotes. Most of them came in under budget. Shurina Brothers and M&M Landscapes were the two quotes.
- Discussion on fountain repair
We had three quotes for the fountain repair.
- Discussion on Demolition for the following properties
Allocated \$75,000.00 this year for a demo, with most of it going to 215 Corbet. A. Bruni noted we submitted a property to the County last cycle for demolition.
- Discussion on Borough Building leak and flooring
We had a leak in the Borough Building and are waiting on the insurance company for reimbursement. We are planning on installing plank flooring and have one estimate now. We are waiting for another one at the next council meeting. Borough Manager Boddorf noted that Unflooded did a great job.
- Discussion on lot consolidation
**note, this is to consolidate lots 1224-J-289 and 1224-J-290
A. Bruni noted these two parcels are on First Avenue, and the plan is to consolidate both into a single lot.*

CITIZENS COMMENT:

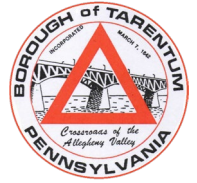
